



## Use of Pupil Premium 2021/22

### Introduction

The Pupil Premium is a Government initiative that provides extra money for vulnerable pupils. Vulnerable pupils are identified as those who are in receipt of free school meals or have been in the last 6 years; looked after children or children who have a parent working for the armed services.

Schools may use their data to decide how best to spend this money. The money must be spent on 'narrowing the gap' between pupils who have been identified as vulnerable in comparison to those who have not. Schools will be accountable for their performance and must report on all aspects of Pupil Premium spending.

### What will we receive?

We receive £1345 for each Primary aged pupil.

We receive £955 for each Secondary aged pupil.
