School Updates

Enrichment activities

Our school places a strong emphasis on holistic development, and we are pleased to report our children participate in various enrichment activities. These experiences not only contribute to their physical well-being but also foster and create an environment to develop their social communication skills. We believe in nurturing wellrounded children and young people, and your child's engagement in these activities is a testament to their growth beyond the academic expectations. Cashless Payment System

The Avenue School is becoming a cashless school and will be implementing a payment system in the new year, further information will be available soon.

Classroom environment

The development of our classroom environments has been one of collaboration and mutual support. We have been reviewing our classroom environments especially as we continue to grow and I look forward to inviting our families into the school to see the progress made very soon.

Pupil progress and achievements

I was pleased to write to you in September to inform you of our process of sharing and discussing your child's progress. We have successfully started this process and parents and carers will be invited to three meetings during the school year – one meeting every term will be held to discuss your child's progress and achievements. The meetings will include one Annual Review meeting and two Home School Conversations:

Meetings:

Annual Review meeting

Each year parents and carers will be invited to attend an annual review meeting for your child. This is the meeting in which we review your child's Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP). In the run up to this meeting you will receive written reports from your child's class teacher, speech and language therapist and occupational therapist alongside reports from any other professionals involved in your child's education, health or care.

Home School Conversation meetings

In addition to your child's annual review parents and carers will be invited to attend two home school conversations. These meetings are an additional opportunity to:

- Agree clear goals and targets for your child's learning
- Share your concerns and your hopes for your child
- Agree how to help your child do better

As we conclude the autumn term, we have some exciting events and celebrations planned, and I am pleased to share a few with you below:

Avenue Annual Walk in the Park

I am truly excited to be organising such an event and will update you in the new year of the details but it will provide a wonderful opportunity for all our families to come together, talk and walk together to celebrate our wonderful children and young people.

Our **Parent Reading Hub** will be launched in January 2024 and information regarding the process i.e. days and times will be shared in the spring term. This will be a wonderful opportunity for parents and carers to read with our pupils.









