Launching a New Maths Project

At The Avenue School, one of our primary goals is to enhance our students' understanding of money and shopping, as this is a fundamental life skill. In line with this objective, we are introducing a school real shop initiative to be integrated into our Maths lessons. This engaging project allows children to visit a portable shop within the school premises, where they can purchase small toys and items while applying and enhancing their mathematical skills. The primary focus of this activity is to enable students to comprehend, familiarise, and experiment with the concept of belongings.
